



U.S. MASTER OF LAWS (LL.M.) PROGRAM IN EGYPT

with Emphasis in Commercial/Business Law

INDIANA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF LAW-INDIANAPOLIS

The Indiana University School of Law-Indianapolis traces its origins to the late nineteenth century when the first of its private predecessor schools, the Indiana Law School, began operating in 1894. The school became affiliated with Indiana University in 1944 and is now the largest law school in the State of Indiana (USA). At its Indianapolis campus, the school offers the J.D., LL.M. and S.J.D. degrees, along with seven joint degrees offered cooperatively with other Indiana University schools. Three academic research centers are located at the school: the Center for International and Comparative Law, the Hall Center for Law and Health, and the Center for Intellectual Property Law and Innovation. The IU School of Law-Indianapolis publishes three academic journals: the *Indiana Law Review*, the *Indiana International and Comparative Law Review* and the *Indiana Health Law Review*. Additionally, the editorial offices of the *European Journal of Law Reform* are housed at the law school. Many prominent individuals are graduates of the IU School of Law-Indianapolis, including a former Vice President of the United States, several U.S. Congressmen and numerous federal, state and local judges. Through a grant from USAID, the law school offers the International and Comparative Law track of its Master of Laws degree on-site at both Cairo University and Alexandria University.

CAIRO UNIVERSITY AND THE FACULTY OF LAW

Cairo University (formerly the Egyptian University and King Fou'ad the First University) is a leading academic institution in the Middle East. Founded in 1908, Cairo University enrolls more than 160,000 students annually. Alumni of Cairo University include eminent scientists and artists, as well as governmental leaders. Among its graduates are a former Secretary General of the United Nations, the current Secretary General of the Arab League, Arab Presidents and Heads of State, and former judges at the International Court of Justice. The Faculty of Law is one of Cairo University's oldest faculties and heads the Arab Union for Faculties of Law. The Faculty of Law includes three main undergraduate sections: the Arabic Section with the majority of students; the English Section, which was the first department offering legal education in English across Egypt; and the French Section, which operates in association with the University of Paris I Pantheon Sorbonne. The Faculty of Law offers a wide variety of postgraduate diplomas and certificates, along with the LL.M. degree and Ph.D. degree.

ALEXANDRIA UNIVERSITY AND THE FACULTY OF LAW

Alexandria University was founded in 1938. Originally, it was a branch of Cairo University (then called Fou'ad alAwwal University). In 1938, the Alexandrian branch of Cairo University was declared an independent University. The law school was the second school to be part of Alexandria University, with its first class graduating in 1941. The law school is the third largest in the nation, with an undergraduate division that hosts 24,000 students annually. The school ranks as the second most important in the country, with graduates spread throughout the Muslim world, serving in all fields of legal practice and as leaders in their communities. The law school at Alexandria prides itself on the quality of its faculty members, more than 70% of whom hold LL.D. degrees from European or American universities. Faculty members have served as an essential force in bringing about some of the most important changes in society, not only in Egypt but throughout the Arab and Muslim world. The school offers one college degree, Bachelor in Laws (LL.B), and three graduate degrees: Graduate Diploma, Masters Degree (LL.M), and Doctorate in Laws (LL.D.).

MASTER OF LAWS PROGRAM INTERNATIONAL AND COMPARATIVE LAW TRACK

The IU School of Law-Indianapolis has collaborated with the Faculties of Law at Alexandria University and Cairo University through the support of a grant from USAID/Egypt to offer its Master of Laws (LL.M.) degree, International and Comparative Law in Egypt.

- LL.M. degree from IU School of Law-Indianapolis
- LL.M. degree is comprised of 24 credit hours, including an LL.M. thesis, and may be earned in as little as three semesters (or 18 months)
- Curricular emphasis on commercial/business law
- Courses taught by full-time and adjunct law faculty of the IU School of Law-Indianapolis
- Small group instruction, evenings only

Eligibility Requirements

An applicant must hold a first degree in law (usually an LL.B. or higher) from an educational institution in a country other than the United States. Alternatively, an applicant with an academic degree other than in law must be licensed to practice law in a jurisdiction outside the United States.

Applicants for whom English is a second language must have a score of at least 575 on the paper-based TOEFL, a score of at least 230 on the computer-based TOEFL, a score of at least 89 on the IBT TOEFL, and a score of at least 6.5 on the IELTS. Qualifying language scores must be less than two years old.

A successful applicant for admission must demonstrate:

1. academic achievement, documented with official academic transcripts, diplomas and/or graduation certificates and two letters of academic reference;
2. professional accomplishment, where applicable, documented with letters of professional reference; and
3. English language competency

Bar Examination Eligibility

The determination of whether a graduate is eligible to sit for a bar exam in any state in the United States rests with the Board of Law Examiners in that state. Eligibility for IU School of Law-Indianapolis LL.M. graduates (including those in Egypt) to sit for any given state bar examination depends upon a state's regulations and upon each graduate's individual credentials.



كلية الحقوق بجامعة إنديانا – إنديانابوليس برنامج الماجستير في القانون فرع القانون الدولي والقانون المقارن

تتعاون كلية الحقوق بجامعة إنديانا – إنديانابوليس مع كليتي الحقوق بجامعة الإسكندرية والقاهرة بمصر لمنح درجة الماجستير في القانون (القانون الدولي والقانون المقارن) في مصر. ويأتي التعاون بدعم من الوكالة الأمريكية للتنمية الدولية.

- يمكن الحصول على درجة الماجستير في القانون من كلية الحقوق بجامعة إنديانا – إنديانابوليس.
- تتكون درجة الماجستير في القانون من 24 ساعة معتمدة أسبوعياً، من ضمنها أطروحة ماجستير القانون، ويمكن إنهاؤها خلال ثلاثة فصول دراسية على الأقل (أو 18 شهراً).
- يركز المنهج الدراسي على القانون التجاري/قانون الأعمال.
- يتم تدريس المناهج الدراسية بواسطة أعضاء هيئة التدريس المتفرغين أو المدرسين المساعدين من كلية الحقوق بجامعة إنديانا – إنديانابوليس
- يتم التدريس في مجموعات صغيرة، وفي مواعيد مسائية فقط.

متطلبات التأهيل

ينبغي أن يكون المتقدم حاصلاً على شهادة جامعية في القانون (ليسانس في الحقوق أو درجة أعلى) من مؤسسة تعليمية من بلد غير الولايات المتحدة الأمريكية. أو كبدل، ينبغي أن يكون المتقدم الحاصل على درجة جامعية في تخصص غير القانون مخصصاً له العمل كمحام لدى سلطة قضائية خارج الولايات المتحدة الأمريكية. وبالنسبة للمتقدمين ممن تكون لغتهم الثانية هي الإنجليزية، يجب أن يحرزوا على 575 درجة على الأقل في اختبارات TOEFL التحريرية، أو 230 درجة على الأقل في اختبارات TOEFL باستخدام الحاسب، أو 89 درجة على الأقل في اختبارات TOEFL عبر الإنترنت، أو 6.5 درجة على الأقل في اختبارات IELTS. ويجب ألا يتجاوز تاريخ نتائج اللغة المؤهلة عامين سابقين على الأكثر.

يجب أن يكون لدى مقدم طلب الالتحاق المؤهل:

- 1- إنجازات جامعية موثقة بشهادات جامعية رسمية و/أو شهادات الدبلومات أو التخرج ورسالتني توصية جامعتين.
- 2- إنجازات مهنية موثقة، إن أمكن، مع رسالتني توصية مهنتين.
- 3- الكفاءة في اللغة الإنجليزية.

التأهل لامتحان ممارسة المحاماة

لجنة ممارسة القانون في كل ولاية هي التي تقوم بتحديد ما إذا كان خريج ما مؤهلاً لاجتياز امتحان ممارسة القانون في أي ولاية داخل الولايات المتحدة الأمريكية. ويتوقف تأهل خريجي القانون من كلية الحقوق بجامعة إنديانا – إنديانابوليس (بما في ذلك المتخرجين من مصر) لاجتياز الامتحان في أي ولاية على لوائح تلك الولاية وعلى المؤهلات الشخصية لكل خريج.
